7. Who receives your data

We use the following service providers under confidentiality agreements: Zoom, WhatsApp, Google Drive, Stripe, PayPal, Kajabi (email marketing), ChatGPT, Claude, Perplexity and an AI note-taker. Data are anonymised before use in ChatGPT, Claude and Perplexity.

8. International transfers

Some providers store data outside Switzerland/EU (e.g., Kajabi – USA; Stripe – USA/EU; PayPal – USA/EU). Transfers rely on Swiss adequacy decisions or Standard Contractual Clauses approved by the Federal Council.

9. Security

Third-party tools use industry-standard safeguards such as HTTPS encryption, role-based access controls and (where available) two-factor authentication. Internally, access is limited to personnel on a need-to-know basis.
